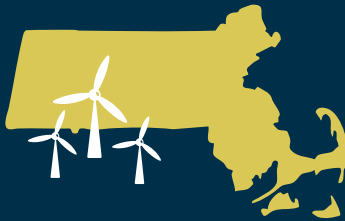

Trump Officials Weigh New Plan to Stop Offshore Wind Farms

AUGUST 22, 2025

The Bureau of Ocean Energy Management (BOEM) halted ongoing construction on the 704 MW Revolution Wind Project that is expected to **power over 350,000 homes** in New England. This order was later dropped.

DECEMBER 22, 2025

BOEM issued orders to suspend all ongoing construction activities at the five offshore wind projects on the East Coast, a combined 5.8 GW of capacity. This included Revolution Wind which had been delayed earlier in the year and Vineyard Wind 1 which was set to provide 800 MW of generation to Massachusetts, enough to **power over 400,000 homes**.

MAY 28, 2026

A House Appropriations subcommittee advanced an Interior spending bill that sought to impose **per-turbine inspection fees** on offshore wind projects. These fees far exceed what oil and gas operators pay for comparable oversight.
